

**ALGER COUNTY ROAD COMMISSION POLICY FOR  
REMOVING ROADS OR PORTIONS OF ROADS FROM  
SEASONAL ROAD STATUS**

It shall be the policy of the ACRC that before a public hearing will be held by the Commission on a request to remove a road or portion of a road from the “seasonal road system”, the township in which the change is proposed to occur must adopt a resolution at a township board meeting supporting the proposed change and provide by way of resolution a statement that the Township is willing to pay a percentage of the cost of upgrading the road, or portion of the road, as determined by the ACRC, petitioned to be removed from the seasonal road system.

Individual applicant requirements to remove a road from a seasonal road system are as follows:

1. An individual that desires a road to be removed from the seasonal road system shall submit their request in writing to the appropriate Township and the Road Commission.
2. The Road Commission will inspect the road and determine what improvements are necessary, if any, to enable the road commission to maintain that road year round.
3. The applicant shall deposit his and/or her share of the estimated cost with the Road Commission before any work will be started. The Township will authorize their participation by signing a standard estimate contract.
4. The road Commission will hold a public hearing regarding the removal of a requested road from the seasonal road system and if determined that said removal is feasible, at the ACRC’s sole discretion, will adopt a resolution removing the road from the seasonal system upon completion of the necessary work required.
